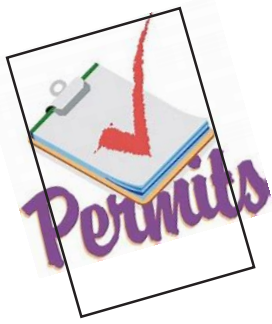

# Changes to Paying for your Permits

Please be aware that we have made changes to how permits and payments are received. All permits and payments are to be filed and paid for at the City of Galesburg offices. Checks will need to be made out to the City of Galesburg.

**City Park Pavilion Rental Fee Change** The fees have changed for renting the park/pavilions. The cost is now \$150. The breakdown of the fees are as follows, if the park/pavilion is left in the same condition as it was found, you will receive \$50 back of you deposit within 30 days of each rental event date. The entire rental fee of \$150 is non-refundable in the event the renter cancels for any reason.
